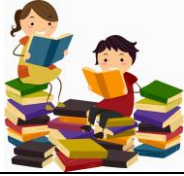


# Year 1 Newsletter Spring Term 2

## English



In English we will be reading stories from fantasy worlds and writing some of our own stories. We will be looking at our own toys and some from the past. We will be reading lots of information books about toys and practising our handwriting. We are currently working on joining two letters together.

## Maths



In Maths we will be learning to measure the length, height, weight and capacity of objects. We will learn to read and write numbers to 50 and beyond. We will also be practising our number bonds and finding one more/less and ten more/less than a number. There will also be work on counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

## Computing



We will be looking at Celebrations and when we might send cards to each other. Last half term we learnt how to search for safe images online and copy and paste them into a document. This term we are using these skills to create our own digital Easter card.

## Topic



In History we will be learning about Toys from the past and how toys have changed through the years. There will be lots of opportunities to bring toys into school - see dates below! In Art we will be learning how to mix colours and in DT we will be making a variety of moving pictures concentrating on sliders, levers and pivots.

There will also be drama, music, indoor and outdoor PE, painting, sketching, role-play activities and show and tell each week.

- Look at how modern toys are made and how they work
- Visit the library to find out about old toys.
