English	In English we will be reading fairy tales and traditional tales and joining in with the patterned language. In our writing we will be practising using capital letters for the names of people and places.
Maths	We will be working on our addition and subtraction skills. Also our place value skills. Sometimes we will be trying to work out the missing number in a sum. We might have to read a short number story and work out what number operation to use. In our lessons we use number lines, Numicon and small objects to support our learning. We will be doing 2D and 3D shape work.
Computing	Our computing unit this half term is called 'We are painters'. We will be looking closely at illustrations from different traditional tales to help us to make our own class e-book. We will upload our e-book onto the learning platform when it is finished.
Topic	In science we will be naming different materials and recognising some of their properties. We will test out different materials to see which is best for the Big Bad Wolf's house.
