- **Review previous meeting minutes**

Mr Goodwin explained that since we have increased from 180 dinners a day to over 300 it is harder to check all items coming out really clean. It takes around 20 mins to drain, reclean and refill dishwasher.

We need to make sure clean hands are used all the time.

The plates should not be touched if your hands not clean.

Lunchtime supervisors to check hands are clean.

Must check hands are being washed.

If your plate is a bit wet you can ask Mr Goodwin to wipe it dry, it is just condensation from the dishwasher.
