English



We will be reading a variety of stories and non-fiction books. These will be a stimulus for our writing. We will continue to learn about phonics and we will start to bring home homework based on the new sounds that we are learning. In our writing, we will continue to focus on writing sentences with finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Maths



In Maths, we will be doing addition and subtraction using lots of practical resources (cubes, counters, small toys etc). We will be looking at how to partition numbers and how we might record this. Please help us to learn our number bonds to 10 at home.

Science & Topic



This half term we will be learning about the 4 Seasons and weather. We will start by focusing on Autumn and looking for signs of Autumn around the school. We will be learning about the UK Autumnal weather and will be recording our own Autumn weather forecast. This will involve learning the names of the 4 countries of the UK and their capital cities.

ICT



In ICT we will become illustrators. We will be using safe search engines to research different types of illustrations and then we will use 2Create a Story to make our own moving illustrations. We will continue to discuss E-Safety and would appreciate your support with this at home.
