English	 In English we will be reading some fiction texts related to other countries to broaden our geography knowledge. We will look at 'Handa's surprise' and 'When Granny went to market'. Out writing targets will be: To use neat handwriting, with some joins. To apply our phonics skills to make good spelling choices. To use capital letters for names of places and people. There will be some assessments to check our reading and whether we can answer questions. In Maths we will be learning position and direction, place value within 100 and some more work on money. We will also learn to tell
	the time to o'clock, and half past. Please practise telling the time at home if possible as this is a great life skill! There will be some assessments to see how much we can remember.
Art	We will be having an ARTS week on 24 th -28 th June. The children will be learning about the artist David Hockney and recreating some of his styles of art work. We will also have workshops with a west end theatre group that visited our school previously in 2018.
ICT	In the computing we will be Treasure hunters learning how to programme a toy. We will do some programming work on screen too and thinking about how to debug a program that doesn't work!
Topic	In our topic work we will learn some key mapping skills whilst we explore the grounds of our school and create simple maps. We will learn to name the countries and capitals of the UK as well as the continents and seas of the world. We will also have a small history project learning about our local area and finding out about the old school and what life was like for school children in the past.
There will also be drama, music, role play activities, PSHE, and show and tell each week.
